Laodicea, which means 'the peoples opinions' or 'the people's rule.' where they lost their first love because they made their opinion greater than Gods command. – THEY LOST THE CAPACITY TO SEE THE ERROR OF THEIR WAY –Laodicea who lost the "WAY" and went THEIR "WAY" And their hearts became lukewarm to the things of the Lord due to their own self sufficiency they had lost the core of the message which is

LOVE – CONSECRATION - DEDICATION

"THEY BECAME THE CHURCH THAT HAD POWER WITHOUT CHARACTER"

NEW TESTAMENT JOHN THE BAPTIST WAS THE MESSENGER MAKING THE WAY FOR JESUS CHRIST. JOHN HAD A NAZARITE VOW Jdgs 13 SAMSON HAD A NAZARITE VOW

both were set apart, both called from the womb both were an answer to prayer both walked in power

ONE HAD CONVICTION - ONE HAD CONTENTION ONE WALKED IN COUNSEL OF THE SPIRIT – ONE WALKED IN THE COUNSEL OF HIS OWN HEART

One humbled himself and cried LORD I MUST DECREASE THAT YOU MIGHT INCREASE – THE OTHER STRUGGLED WITH HUMILITY, only recorded that Samson prayed twice.

Samson is a typical picture of one

who moves in power but without character

one who was ruled by ones own opinion He is a picture of the Laodicean Church; who forgot the "the reason why He had been called" - and succumbed to his own reasoning Had all the DEMONSTRATION of the externals (strength – recognition) without the internal conviction to guard his soul....

HE HAD POWER WITHOUT – HUMILITY AND CONVICTION VOW OF A NAZARITE WAS UPON HIM - BUT THE VOW NEVER HAD HIM

SO SAMSON STRUGGLED IN HIS WALK - HIS GREATEST STRUGGLE WAS IDENTITY

- Matth4 DEVIL ATTACKS JESUS ON THE MOUNT 2 OF THE 3 TEMPTATION QUESTIONS INVOLVED IDENTITY. DEVIL ATTACKS IDENTITY SO WE BECOME HALF HEARTED IN OUR WALK WHICH CAUSES US TO LOSE VISION AND SURRENDER MORALLY TO STRIP US OF OUR CONSECRATION AND ULTIMATELY OUR STRENGTH TO FULFIL MY DESTINY IN WHAT HE CALLED ME FOR FROM MY MOTHERS WOMB TO FULFIL....

a) separation. 6:1-12

b) worship. 6:13-21

c) blessing. 6:22-27

d) service. 7:1-89
