THE RESURRECTION OF JESUS CHRIST WAS NOT A RESUSCITATION OF THE OLD BUT A RESURRECTION OF THE NEW

1Jn\_3:2 Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

## 1Co 15:42 -54

- So also is the resurrection of the dead. The body is sown in corruption, it is raised in incorruption.
- 1Co 15:43 It is sown in dishonor, it is raised in glory. It is sown in weakness, it is raised in power.
- 1Co 15:44 It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body. There is a natural body, and there is a spiritual body.
- 1Co 15:45 And so it is written, "THE FIRST MAN ADAM BECAME A LIVING BEING." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.
- 1Co 15:46 However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual.
- 1Co 15:47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.
- 1Co 15:48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; and as is the heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly.

- 1Co 15:49 And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.
- 1Co 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption.
- 1Co 15:51 Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed—
- 1Co 15:52 in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed.
- 1Co 15:53 For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.
- 1Co 15:54 So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "DEATH IS SWALLOWED UP IN VICTORY."
- 1Co 15:55 "O DEATH, WHERE IS YOUR STING? O HADES, WHERE IS YOUR VICTORY?"
- 1Co 15:56 The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law.
- 1Co 15:57 But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

## Joh 20:14-19

- 4 Now when she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing *there*, and did not know that it was Jesus.
- Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you seeking?" She, supposing Him to be the gardener, said to Him, "Sir, if You have carried Him away, tell me where You have laid Him, and I will take Him away."
- l6 Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to Him, "Rabboni!" (which is to say, Teacher).
- Jesus said to her, "Do not cling to Me, for I have not yet ascended to My Father; but go to My brethren and say to them, 'I am ascending to My Father and your Father, and to My God and your God.' "

HIS WORK ON EARTH WAS FINISHED, YET IT WAS UNFINISHED IN HEAVEN
JESUS SAID I HAVE TO "ASCEND TO MY FATHER AND YOUR FATHER AND TO MY GOD AND YOUR GOD"

#### HEB 9v23 -28

- Heb 9:22 And according to the law almost all things are purified with blood, and without shedding of blood there is no remission.
- Heb 9:23 Therefore it was necessary that the copies of the things in the heavens should be purified with these, but the heavenly things themselves with better sacrifices than these.
- Heb 9:24 For Christ has not entered the holy places made with hands, which are copies of the true, (THE TABERNACLE) but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us;
- Heb 9:25 not that He should offer Himself often, as the high priest enters the Most Holy Place every year with blood of another—
- Heb 9:26 He then would have had to suffer often since the foundation of the world; but now, once at the end of the ages, He has appeared to put away sin by the sacrifice of Himself.
- Heb 9:27 And as it is appointed for men to die once, but after this the judgment,
- Heb 9:28 so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many. To those who eagerly wait for Him He will appear a second time, apart from sin, for salvation.

# THE BLOOD IS PRESENTED AS THE PROPITIATION (ATONEMENT - the act of gaining or regaining the favor or goodwill of someone) IS COMPLETE THE NEW COVENANT IS RATIFIED HIS BLOOD HAS BEEN PLACED ON THE HEAVENLY MERCY SEAT ONCE FOR ALL

**LUKE 24V13** He immediately returns from presenting the blood on the mercy seat of HEAVEN ratifying the NEW COVENANT, to fulfil His commission - meets His disciples on the Emmaus Road -

He Reveals the marks of His testimony by breaking bread – delivered hope through a spoken word that ignited their hearts that caused them to have a turn around!

THEY RETURNED TO JERUSALEM (Lk24v33) THEY GATHER IN A ROOM WITH THE DOOR CLOSED RESURRECTED JESUS COMES INTO THERE CLOSED DOOR MEETING AFTER PRESENTING THE BLOOD AND RATIFYING THE NEW COVENANT NOW YOU CAN TOUCH ME (LK24v19)

**JN20v19** Then, the same day at evening, being the first day of the week, when the doors were shut where the disciples were assembled, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst, and said to them, "Peace be with you."
