Mat 28:19 Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

Mat 28:20 teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Deu 8:1 "Every commandment which I command you today you must be careful to observe, that you may live and multiply, and go in and possess the land of which the LORD swore to your fathers.

Deu 8:2 And you shall remember that the LORD your God led you all the way these forty years in the wilderness, to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep His commandments or not.

Deu 8:3 So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you *know that man shall not live by bread alone; but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.*

Luk 24:13 Now behold, two of them were traveling that same day to a village called Emmaus, which was seven miles from Jerusalem.

Luk 24:14 And they talked together of all these things which had happened.

Luk 24:15 So it was, while they conversed and reasoned, that Jesus Himself drew near and went with them.

Luk 24:16 But their eyes were restrained, so that they did not know Him.

Luk 24:17 And He said to them, "What kind of conversation is this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?"

Luk 24:18 Then the one whose name was Cleopas answered and said to Him, "Are You the only stranger in Jerusalem, and have You not known the things which happened there in these days?"

Luk 24:19 And He said to them, "What things?" So they said to Him, "The things concerning Jesus of Nazareth, who was a Prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people,

Luk 24:20 and how the chief priests and our rulers delivered Him to be condemned to death, and crucified Him.

Luk 24:21 But we were hoping that it was He who was going to redeem Israel. Indeed, besides all this, today is the third day since these things happened.

Luk 24:22 Yes, and certain women of our company, who arrived at the tomb early, astonished us.

Luk 24:23 When they did not find His body, they came saying that they had also seen a vision of angels who said He was alive.

Luk 24:24 And certain of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but Him they did not see."

Luk 24:25 Then He said to them, "O foolish ones, and slow of heart to believe in all that the prophets have spoken!

Luk 24:26 Ought not the Christ to have suffered these things and to enter into His glory?"

Luk 24:27 And beginning at Moses and all the Prophets, He expounded to them in all the Scriptures the things concerning Himself.

Luk 24:28 Then they drew near to the village where they were going, and He indicated that He would have gone farther.

Luk 24:29 But they constrained Him, saying, "Abide with us, for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent." And He went in to stay with them.

Luk 24:30 Now it came to pass, as He sat at the table with them, that He took bread, blessed and broke it, and gave it to them.

Luk 24:31 Then their eyes were opened and they knew Him; and He vanished from their sight.

Luk 24:32 And they said to one another, "Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?"

Luk 24:33 So they rose up that very hour and returned to Jerusalem, and found the eleven and those who were with them gathered together,

Jesus came along side these 2, it the day of His resurrection and He walked with them nearly the whole day those who were walking away from Jerusalem the place where they were to wait. To Emmaus - Lukewarm

TO "RE-IGNITE THEIR FAITH" TO BRING BACK PERSPECTIVE IN THEIR THINKING TO RE-ALIGN THEM TO THEIR ASSIGNMENT - they had left the community of the 11 Apostles and the other disciples and started to walk a Road of doubt and disappointment.

THE OTHERS WERE IN JERUSALEM WAITING When people walk on the Emmaus Road their conversation begins to change

v17 "What kind of conversation is this that you have with one another as you walk and are sad?"

THEIRS A MAKING IN THE WAITING AND THE FOLLOWING

They had lost hope - What caused them to withdraw and start to doubt what He had said? -

The Lack of ability to see Him - lack of the word lack of understanding the word

THREE THINGS JESUS HAD TO OPEN TO RESTORE THEM TO A WALK OF FAITH

- 1. HE OPENED THEIR EYES TO SEE AND THEY KNEW HIM v31
- 2. HE OPENED THE SCRIPTURES TO REVEAL HIMSELF AND IGNITE A FIRE v32
- 3. HE OPENED THEIR UNDERSTANDING TO COMPREHEND THE SCRIPTURES v45

THEY HAD GOT A TASTE OF THE POWER AND THE WORK OF THE HOLY GHOST

WHEN YOUR IN COMMUNION WITH THE SPIRIT - HIS PRIMARY TASK IS THAT YOU MIGHT KNOW HIM—CHRIST JESUS

Php 3:10 that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death,

YOU'LL THEN BE ASKED BY HIM TO WALK BY FAITH!

V25 Foolish thinking and a "slow OR DULL heart" = 2 AREAS ATTACKED THINKING AND BELIEVING

Wrong conversation and a FAITH that has been reasoned away, leads me further away from His promises.

BUT HE IS A FAITHFUL GOD AND

EVEN THOU I CANT RECOGINSE HIM - HE RECOGNISES ME!!!!

HE SPEAKS WORD TO ME UNTIL THAT WHICH BLINDED ME FALLS AWAY AS I EAT AT HIS TABLE AND MY DULL HEART BURNS AGAIN BY THE REVELATION OF THE POWER OF HIS WORD

WE HAVE GOT TO GET BACK TO THAT PLACE OF FAITH AND WAIT ON HIM

THAT HE WILL RE - IGNITE THAT FIRE IN MY SPIRIT

AS I TAKE A HOLD OF HIM AND HIS WORD; AND HE REVEALS HIMSELF THAT I MIGHT

SEE

Did not our heart burn within us while He talked with us on the road, and while He opened the Scriptures to us?" - REKINDLE THE PASSION
